

Important statement by Mayor Cranna regarding detection of sulfur odor in Tivoli water supply

October 29, 2011

*"Earlier this afternoon I was briefed by the Village Engineer and Deputy Mayor Leedy regarding the detection of a sulfur odor in the water supply in certain areas of the village; particularly in homes on North Road, Spring Street, Montgomery Street, and Washburne Avenue. Both the Village Engineer and the Superintendent of Public Works have determined that there are no health risks associated with the odor which appears to be subsiding.
