

PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE
VILLAGE OF TIVOLI
WATERFRONT VISIONING SESSION

The Village of Tivoli is hosting a public visioning session to discuss the development of a waterfront park on Tuesday, October 13, 2009 from 7 to 9 pm at the historic Watts dePeyster Hall, 1 Tivoli Commons, Tivoli, New York.

For nearly two decades, the Village has been working to acquire land and develop a waterfront park to protect community access to the Hudson River. A public information discussion on the community's vision for use and design of the proposed waterfront park will assist in outlining the next steps of designing the park. This session will also be attended by representatives from various public and private agencies, including New York State Department of State, Department of Environmental Conservation Estuaries Program, who have offered generous support to the Village in pursuit of maintaining safe riverfront access.

The forum will include a brief overview of the history and current status of the project; two breakout sessions for community members to discuss specific use and design ideas; and discussion about the obstacles to and benefits of permanent public access to the Hudson River.

State Assemblyman and former-mayor Marc Molinaro will join local and state officials in moderating the dialogue. All residents are encouraged to attend and participate.
