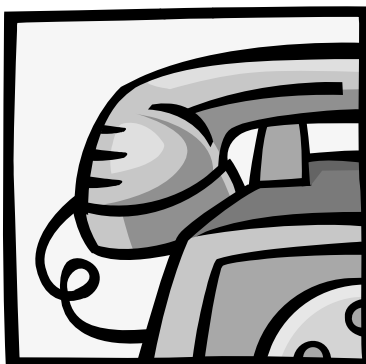

- Paper must be bundled & cardboard broken down

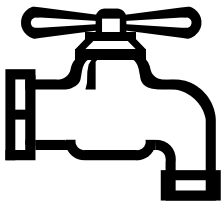

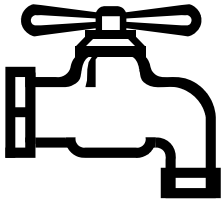

Water & Sewer

- Billed quarterly, due the 15th of the month: June, Sept., Dec., March
- New users must complete a Change of Account Form
- Contact Village Offices for up to date consumption rates



Garbage Collection

- Collection is every Tuesday, beginning at 7:00 am
- Garbage bag tags must be purchased and adhered to all trash bags for pickup
- Garbage bags w/tags must curbside be in cans for no longer than 12 hours prior
- Glass, plastic & tin must be curbside in a sturdy re-usable container
- Paper must be bundled & cardboard broken down

Garbage Tag Prices: For use with 30 gallon bag: \$3

Parking, streets & sidewalks

Snow Removal:

- Sidewalks must be cleaned within 24 hours of a snowfall (after snowfall ends)
- Snow cannot be thrown or left in a public right-of-way (ie. Streets, sidewalks, etc.)
- Fines may be levied, a \$100 per hour charge issued for the Village DPW to complete the work

Overnight Parking:

- On street parking is prohibited from 1 am to 6 am, between Nov. 15 and April 1
- Overnight parking permits are required for all municipal lots
- Call the Village Offices at (845) 757-2021 to obtain a permit

Masonic Hall Municipal Parking Lot (North Road)

- Lot closes from 9 – 11 am during and after a snowfall for cleaning
- Overnight parking allowed on south side of lot only, a permit is required
- All violators of parking lot rules will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense

Broadway Municipal Parking Lot (Broadway)

- Lot closes from 9 – 11 am during and after a snowfall for cleaning
- Overnight parking allowed, a permit is required
- All violators of parking lot rules will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense

Schoolhouse Municipal Parking Lot (Pine Street)

- Lot closes from 9 – 11 am during and after a snowfall for cleaning
- Overnight parking allowed, a permit is required (Please park against concrete barriers)
- All violators of parking lot rules will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense

Tivoli Commons Municipal Parking Lot

- Lot closes from 9 – 11 am during and after a snowfall for cleaning
- Overnight parking allowed, a permit is required
- Public parking is prohibited in Village Official & Emergency Vehicle spaces
- All violators of parking lot rules will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense

Abandoned Vehicles

- Any vehicle left unattended or unmoved for more than 72 hours on any public property or municipal parking lot is considered abandoned and may be towed at the owner's expense
