**REGULAR MEETING**

## MARCH 14, 2006

The Regular Meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was held on March 14, 2006 at Watts dePeyster Hall. Called to order at 5:05pm.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Molinaro, Trustees Cordier, Staffiero, Hogan and Cranna

Public: Christine Chale (Village Attorney), Mona Herman, Ken McCarthy and Mike Leedy

The Minutes from the February 22, 2006 Local Law #1-2006 Public Hearing were approved on a motion by Trustee Cordier, seconded by Trustee Staffiero, all in favor.

The Minutes from the February 22, 2006 Local Law #2-2006 Public Hearing were approved on a motion by Trustee Cranna, seconded by Trustee Hogan, all in favor.

The Minutes from the February 22, 2006 Regular Meeting were approved on a motion by Trustee Cordier, seconded by Trustee Staffiero, all in favor.

The Clerk reported the following:

- A) Village Elections are March 21, 2006 between 12-9pm
- B) The Great River Sweep will be April 23, 2006 at 1pm at the River
- C) Town of Red Hook recycling permits may be purchased in the village office

The bills (#466-499) for Abstract #10, in the amount of \$17,870.20, were approved to be paid on a motion by Trustee Hogan, seconded by Trustee Staffiero, all in favor.

On a motion by Trustee Cordier, the Board received the Treasurer's Report dated March 14, 2006, seconded by Trustee Cranna, all in favor.

ZEO Report dated March 13, 2006 was submitted. (See attached)

Mayor Molinaro reported the following:

- A) The 2006/2007 Budget Public Hearing will be held Wednesday, April 12, 2006 at 6:00pm with the regular monthly meeting to follow. A workshop will be held prior to the public hearing. Date and time to be announced.
- B) The Re-Organizational Meeting will be held Thursday, April 13, 2006 at 7:00pm.
- C) On a motion by Trustee Cranna, the Board approved the Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement with PANDA, seconded by Trustee Cordier, all in favor.
- D) **RESOLUTION #13-2006/A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF TIVOLI TO AWARD CONTRACT NO. 1925.0 TO CONSTRUCT THE REED BEDS AT THE VILLAGE'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT** was approved on a motion by Trustee Cordier, seconded by Trustee Cranna, all in favor. Roll Call-Trustees Cordier, Staffiero, Hogan and Cranna-yes, Mayor Molinaro -yes. J. Mullen & Sons was the lowest bid at \$81,000 for the reed bed project.
- E) **RESOLUTION #14-2006/APPROVING REVISED PARK USE PERMIT RULES** was approved on motion by Trustee Cranna, seconded by Trustee Hogan, all in favor. Trustee Cranna thanked the Committee and Ms. Herman. He believes the new rules clear up gray areas.

- F) Mona Herman was given the opportunity to speak about the WiFi contract. She stated her concerns about the wireless antennae installation on the water tower. She also said if the WiFi contract is not terminated she will file an Article 78. A signed petition was submitted to the Board (on file in the village office). A Pine Street resident also voiced her concern. Mayor Molinaro responded that he doesn't feel the Village is acting contrary to the law. He is aware of the health issue dialogue. The equipment is FCC approved. The wireless waves are already in the Village. The contract will be monitored and if there are any negative impacts from the antennae the contract would not be renewed.

Trustee Cordier reported the following:

- A) The annual inspection at the waste water treatment plant was made by the DEC and was found to operating in a satisfactory manner with no major deficiencies.
- B) He spoke to the Dutchess County Resource Recovery regarding conducting a study on solid waste collection.
- C) Waterfront land purchase- checking into an 1850 deed restriction on building on part of the parcel.
- D) He's working with the Department of State to update a part or all of the LWRP
- E) The garbage and recycling collection with the Village of Red Hook went well last week.

Trustee Staffiero reported the following:

- A) Fire Department Report: a) OSHA training will be March 19<sup>th</sup>. b) The annual dinner is March 19<sup>th</sup>. c) The company approved purchasing new marching uniforms.

Trustee Hogan reported the following:

- A) February Court Report (on file in the village office).

Trustee Cranna reported the following:

- A) A ground breaking ceremony will probably take place within the next few weeks for the new park equipment. Approximately \$5000 has been donated towards the new equipment.
- B) The Recreation Committee has collected almost \$1500 in donations from residents to go to committee sponsored events.

On a motion by Trustee Cranna, seconded by Trustee Staffiero, the Board adjourned this portion of the Regular Meeting to reconvene after the 6:30pm Public Hearing.
